Privacy

FSANZ is bound by the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) outlined in Schedule 1 of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (Privacy Act), which regulates how entities may collect, use, disclose and store personal information.

This form (for Survey 1) asks you provide your personal information (e.g., your name; practice's name or type; your practice's location, including the suburb and state; and email address).

This form also asks you to provide general information in relation to any mustard-allergic patients you may have. Please do not include information in your survey response that could identify any particular patient.

Your survey response, including any personal information supplied, is being collected by Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) for the purposes of monitoring mustard allergy in the Australian and New Zealand populations following introduction of rapeseed protein isolate into the food supply.

FSANZ will use the information you provide to inform policy development.

The information you provide will also assist FSANZ in undertaking the survey; and in collating and checking survey results, including communicating with you about your survey response.

FSANZ only use and disclose personal information contained in your survey response in accordance with the Privacy Act (including the APPs).

Your personal information will not be disclosed to any other third parties, except where required by law or the Parliament of Australia.

FSANZ does not intend to identify any individual in the reporting of the survey results and will take all reasonable steps to de-identify summary data to be included in publicly available reports.

By including personal information in your survey response, you consent to FSANZ collecting, using and disclosing that information in accordance with this Notice and the APP (Australian Privacy Principles) 5 Notice for FSANZ surveys.
